

NECTM8 Abstract guidelines



NECTM8 explicitly invites all travel medicine professional groups, such as GP's, nurses and students to submit their work.

Important dates

2 December 2019, Abstract submission open

Abstracts can only be submitted online via the conference website. Before submitting, be sure to read the abstract submission guidelines closely.

28 February 2020, Abstract submission deadline

All scientific abstract submissions must be received no later than February 28, 2020. Late or incomplete submissions will be ineligible for review.

April 2020, Notice of acceptance status to authors

Author notification will be sent out ultimately the 4th of April 2020 by e-mail. All approved abstract titles will be publicized. When your abstract has been approved you need to register to the conference in order to be able to present your abstract. If you do not register to the conference your abstract will be removed from the program.

Instructions for abstract submission

All abstracts will be reviewed by the [Local Scientific Committee](#) using the following criteria: scientific content, and relevance to the conference. Please read the abstracts requirements below. The abstracts can be accepted for oral or poster presentation. Presenters may suggest preference for poster or oral presentation. Abstracts must be submitted through the abstract submission portal through the conference website.

Abstract submission topics

We encourage submissions within the following topics:

- Pre-travel consultation
- Post-travel care
- Vaccines
- Special travellers (migrants, business travellers, chronically ill, elderly, immunosuppressed, paediatrics etc.)
- Maritime medicine
- Sustainability and travel
- Other

You can select one of the main topics from the category list in the abstract submission portal through the conference website.

Specifications for abstracts

Language

- Abstracts should be written in English.

Text

- Each abstract should contain no more than 350 words.

Tables and Illustrations

- If you wish you may upload one file with a table or a figure in the abstract submission form. Note that only one file can be uploaded.

The abstract should contain the following:

- Title: Make the title brief, clearly indicating the nature of the investigation. Do not use capital letters.
- Authors: First name and last name. e.g.: Johan Smith.
- Affiliations: Name of the institutional affiliation, city and country (no address).
- Structure of the abstract:
 - Background of the study: Purpose of the study, preferably one sentence
 - Method(s)
 - Results: Summary of results presented in sufficient detail to support the conclusions. Results stated in the abstracts must be complete (though concise) and final.
 - Conclusion(s)

To review and make changes of your abstract

When your abstract submission is confirmed you will receive a confirmation email. It will be possible to make changes until the abstract submission deadline. You can login to the abstract portal so that you can make changes of your abstract.

Terms and conditions

With the submission of an abstract to NECTM8, the presenting author:

- will make sure all information regarding the abstract submission is correct.
- has not or will not publish or present the abstract before NECTM8.
- indicates the author(s) own the copyright to all information in the abstract or have secured any needed copyrights and understand that submission of the abstract constitutes consent to publication (e.g. Conference app, program etc.).
- will be required to disclose any conflict of interest.
- states that for all studies involving human or animal subjects, permission has been obtained from the relevant regulatory authority and informed consent given where appropriate.
- will be notified about the status of the abstract.
- will be responsible for informing the other authors about the status of the abstract.
- must register for the conference when an abstract is accepted by the Local Scientific Committee.
